

Stagehand Camera Operating Conditions

Pertaining to all areas in the PCC

When a camera needs to be operated at the PCC, there are a few conditions that must be followed in order to record videography without the use of stagehand service.

When are stagehands <u>required</u> for videography?

- If an outside company is hired to perform recording.
- If the equipment is rented and if the rental provider is on site.
- If the equipment requires cabling or power.
- If the recording is more than 30 minutes capture for 3 minutes of use.
- If the videography requires lighting, projection, or audio.
- Television crews. (Some are assigned to electricians)

When are stagehands *not required* for **Local News** videography?

In the PCC:

- If the recording equipment is a portable handheld self-contained device. Tri-pods permitted.
- The equipment does not require cabling, lighting, or audio.
- Broadcasting wirelessly.

In exhibit booths:

• Stagehands operate all lighting, sound, projection and video equipment in exhibit booths (Except cabling and power under the floor-Electricians)
